TRAIN: Trains run between London (Liverpool Street) and Colchester (North Station) at approximately half-hourly intervals; the journey takes under an hour. Services also connect with Colchester from Norwich, Ipswich, Felixstowe, Harwich and Clacton/Walton

COACH: Regular Services to Colchester Bus Station operate from most parts of Britain, either direct or through London. There is a coach service which runs between the University and Stansted Airport TAXI: There are taxi ranks at Colchester North Station, Colchester Bus Station and in the town centre. The journey to the University normally takes about ten minutes and should ask for South Courts.

LOCAL BUSES: The University is served by the following buses: Ask for the South Courts stop. From Colchester North Station: 61, 62 to Valley Road or from Colchester Bus Station: 74, 75 and 78
